

# SPITI TOUR 2021



This cold desert mountain Spiti valley in the high Himalayas lies on the Indo-Tibetan border. It is on an altitude of 12,500 feet above sea level. This Valley is a major center for the Buddhist culture and has some of the oldest Buddhist monasteries. In contrast to the usual mountain scenery, these mountains are relatively dry and rocky having a unique structure. There is no human interference with nature here being one of the most remote areas in the country. This is a place where you can get away from everyone and everything and enjoy the quiet, peaceful environment. There is nothing but land, mountains, animals and the river to listen to. Because of the unique experience, Spiti valley trips are becoming a choice of adventure seekers.

# DETAILED PLAN

## DAY 01: Delhi/Chandigarh to Manali by Overnight Volvo

Arrive at Delhi and board the overnight Volvo from the ISBT Kashmere Gate terminal. Driving past Chandigarh, Bilaspur, Mandi & Kullu, you will arrive at Manali by the morning of next day.

## Day 2: Arrive Manali. Rest day at Manali

- Arrive Manali by morning, and checkin to the hotel
- The day is at leisure to self explore Manali. Visit some famous places like Old Manali, Hidimba Temple, Jogini Falls, Vashisht
- Introduction with Road Captains and Bike Allocation and Ride Orientation & Briefing will be done in the evening before dinner.
- Overnight stay and dinner will be at Manali Hotel

## Day 3: Manali to Sarahan via Tirthan Valley

- After early breakfast, we start the ride towards serene village, Sarahan
- This day on our Royal Enfields we thump across the Kullu valley and enter the famous Tirthan valley
- Riding across the Tirthan valley, we cross famous places like Banjar, Jibhi and Jalori Pass
- We arrive at Sarahan by the evening.
- Overnight stay and dinner will be at hotel

## Day 4: Sarahan to Kalpa via Chitkul

- After breakfast, start the ride towards the last Indian Village Chitkul
- On the way to Chitkul, ride acrosss beautiful Sangla valley

- We will arrive at Chitkul by the afternoon. Have lunch at Chitkul by the river side
- Post lunch and exploration of Chitkul, we ride towards Kalpa. Visit the famous Suicide point in Roghi and Kalpa temple
- Overnight stay and dinner in hotel

### **Day 5: Kalpa to Tabo via Nako**

- After early breakfast, we start the ride towards Tabo
- Enroute Tabo, we ride across the famous Confluence of Satluj & Spiti river, Kazigs & Nako village
- Visit Nako Helipad and beautiful Nako lake. Post lunch, continue the ride towards Tabo.
- This is the day, we cross Kinnaur and enter Spiti Valley
- Arrive at Tabo by the evening and check in to the hotel. Evening will be at leisure to explore Tabo.
- Overnight stay and dinner will be at Tabo hotel

### **Day 6: Tabo to Kaza via Pin Valley**

- Today we ride towards the Headquarter of Spiti, Kaza
- We will start the ride and our first destination will be famous Dhankar Monastery
- After visiting Dhankar, we continue the ride towards the Pin Valley. We will enter the Heart of Pin Valley and visit one of the most isolated villages, Mudh
- Have lunch at Mudh and ride towards Kaza. The evening will be at leisure to explore Kaza town
- Overnight stay and dinner will be at Kaza hotel

### **Day 7: Kaza - Komik - Hikkim - Langza - Chiccham - Key - Kibber**

- The day is to explore the places around Kaza
- Take a day ride to Key Monastery, Kibber, Langza, Komik villages
- By evening return to Kaza and take a walk across the Kaza market
- Overnight stay at Kaza hotel

### **Day 8: Kaza to Chandratal via Kunzum Pass**

- Start Ride from Kaza to Chandratal
- Encountering multiple water crossings
- Reach Chandratal by evening
- Short trek to lake
- Evening stay in Swiss Tents with delicious dinner and bon fire

### **Day 9: Chandratal to Manali via Rohtang Pass**

- After breakfast we start the ride towards Rohtang pass
- Crossing Gramphu and Batal we will reach Rohtang by afternoon
- Take a stop at Rohtang to witness the breathtaking view of Himalayan ranges and green meadows
- We will arrive Manali by the evening. Explore the famous cafes of Old Manali in the evening, Overnight stay and dinner will be at Manali hotel

### **Day 10: Manali to Delhi by Overnight Volvo**

- Say goodbye to all the fellow riders
- Board the overnight Volvo for Delhi
- Early morning arrive at Delhi

## **PAYMENT POLICY:**

1. 30% of the Total Billing Amount to be deposited as the booking amount at the time of the booking
2. Remainder 70% of the Total Billing Amount to be deposited before 30 days of the departure date
3. Failure to adhere to the Payment Policy can lead to a cancellation of the booking without any prior notice to the booking person
4. Cost will increase in case of total pax less than 4

## **CANCELLATION POLICY:**

1. Any cancellations made up to 30 days prior the departure date would attract a 20% cancellation of the total ticket value.
2. Any cancellations made within 30 days of the departure date would attract 100% cancellation of the total ticket value.
3. Fail to do the 30% amount within a month of the booking or 3 months prior to the travel date, whichever is sooner, the booking will stand cancelled without any prior intimation, and the amount received by the company will be forfeited with no refund.

## THINGS TO CARRY FOR SPITI LADAKH ROAD TRIP

Here is a list of essential things one should carry for a trip to Spiti, while we can tell you the essential but kindly think of your requirements also. Families coming with kids should carry stuff you kids need. We feel a cross check of luggage with this list before leaving, would be helpful to many of us in reducing the chances of forgetting some small things while we go on a trip. This way we can enjoy the trip without worrying over the availability of some item.

### SAFETY GEARS (Only for Bike Riders)

Riding Gears are Mandatory for bike riders. (Compulsory for both Rider and pillion Rider). Full face helmets. Provided along with bike in case of rented bike

Winter Biking Gloves, Knee Pads and Elbow Pads (Available on rental basis) Rain Coat

Boots and Boots Cover / Gum Boots

### DOCUMENTS:

Itinerary Printout (at least 1)

Two passport size photographs copy of passport and visa, copy of international drivers permit (For foreign National)

At least 4 Copies of Photo ID proof for all members. (Pan Card is not Valid ID proof) Valid driving License in case you are driving / riding. (Pillion rider don't need it)

Bike / Car paper (In case you bringing your own bike/ Car)

## **ACCESSORIES:**

Mobile phone. BSNL number if possible. Otherwise Airtel post-paid also work most places. BSNL work in most of the terrains.

Camera (Your choice)

Mobile Charger & Power bank

Pen and a small Diary, Bag locks (2 or more) Sunglasses - Recommended. Both for safety and style

Recommended for remote areas - Small water bottle, say 500 ml Plastic Bags / Plastic Zip Lock Bags Twist-ties, safety pins

## **TOILETRIES:**

Tooth Brush & Paste

Toilet Soap/ Hand sanitizer. Tissue papers and hand towel.

Face wash and Deodorant ( you will need it if you want to skip bath) Moisturizing Cream and Talc powder.(A MUST FOR BIKE RIDERS) Sunscreen recommended.

Lip Guard (very much needed) Comb, Shaving Kit and Cold Cream

## **CLOTHING KIT:**

Best way to choose clothes is - Spread all your clothes you wanted to carry for trip on bed. Now remove 50% out as per priority. Now you got the best clothes. Avoid too much of clothes you will end up wearing half of it. But you will end up wasting lots of time in packing and unpacking while others will be enjoying outside

1 Towel

4 - 6 Pairs of socks (woolen) 1 pair of flip flops



At least two light jackets

Warm head cover, ear covers & Forehead covers (To avoid getting AMS in high altitude due to cold winds).

2 heavy woolen jacket Woollen hand gloves

At least 1-2 pairs of thermal - Most useful thing. This way your bag comes down to half its size. Rain coat - A Must thing. Even if it's not raining it will save you from cold winds, mud and water on roads.

2-3 Jeans / Track pants (If you want more comfort) and 3 to 4 T shirt.
